Razer announces the Mechanical Keyboard Case-- a self-explanatory accessory for the 12.9-inch iPad Pro offering what the company claims are superior buttons.



The "mechanical" part of the name comes from what is described as "the world's first low-profile mechanical switch." The result, according to Razer, provides the same feel and performance as a mechanical keyboard from slim chiclet keycaps.

Most other iPad keyboards use a membrane or other similar technologies to detect key presses.

The keyboard keys are individually backlit with 20 brightness levels, while battery life ranges from 600 hours with backlighting off to just 10 hours at maximum brightness. Connectivity comes via Bluetooth (not Smart Connector), and the case comes complete with a multi-angle kickstand.
