

Smaller iPad Pro Gets Twelve South Cases

Twelve South announces versions of the BookBook and SurfacePad covers fitting the 9.7-inch iPad Pro, both featuring leather construction and built-in kickstand for hands-free tablet viewing.

As the name suggests the BookBook has a look reminiscent of a book, specifically one of the vintage variety. Designed for artists, it comes complete with a Pencil holster inside the spine and a kickstand turning the iPad Pro into an easel. The interior is covered in soft microfibre while the hardback covers and reinforced spine provide impact protection.

Meanwhile the SurfacePad is a "luxury" leather cover with a built-in multi-angle viewing stand and a typing wedge fitting a keyboard accessory. It sticks to the back of the tablet (instead of snapping on), and has magnets for automatic sleep/wake functionality.

The BookBook is also available for the 12.9-inch iPad Pro, while the SurfacePad comes in versions fitting the iPad Air, iPad Air 2 and the iPad mini.
