

OWC Intros 13-Port Thunderbolt 3 Dock

OWC Digital presents a Thunderbolt 3 USB-C Dock ideal for use with the latest laptops, such as the MacBook Pro-- one featuring 13 ports and full Thunderbolt 3 support for transfer speeds of up to 40GB/s.



The dock supports the connection of two UHD 4K displays, or a combination of 4K, HD and other displays using the DisplayPort and Thunderbolt 3 ports. Two Thunderbolt 3/USB-C ports support up to 5 daisychained Thunderbolt 3 devices, while five USB-A 3.1 Gen 1 ports support USB-A accessories, with two ports featuring fast charging capabilities.

Other ports include FireWire 800, gigabit ethernet, mini DisplayPort, SD card reader, audio combo and S/PDIF digital audio.

"With our critically-acclaimed Thunderbolt 2 Dock and USB-C Dock, OWC defined a new standard in providing more connectivity at a time when new computers were shipping with fewer ports," OWC says. "The all-new Thunderbolt 3 Dock is the best expansion solution we've ever made, offering the incredible speed of Thunderbolt 3 technology coupled with 13 ports of connectivity, perfect for getting the most out of the new 2016 MacBook Pro."
