Peripheral maker SteelSeries joins forces with Targus, "the original creator of the laptop bag," to create the SteelSeries x Targus Sniper-- a backpack able to hold a laptop up to 17.3-inch in size.



According to the two companies the Sniper is designed for gamer customers. It has a durable exterior, a padded laptop compartment and a "SafePort Sling Protection" system protecting the laptop from knocks and drops. An integrated rain cover protects everything from, well, the rain, while the main compartment holds a large mousemat, mouse, keyboard and controller.

The various compartments are detachable for versatility, and feature "clever materials choices" for more secure storage. Thus, it has a compartment for x2 headsets together with hidden water bottle storage on the side, a secret pouch personal belongings or small valuables and x2 detachable pouches (one small, one dedicated for cables and a headset).

In total the backpack has 26l capacity. It measures $35 \times 33 \times 55$ cm, and weighs 1.8kg. However SteelSeries still has to announce when it will actually be available.
