TP-Link aims to combine the mesh router with the smart home hub-- the Deco M9 Plus mesh wifi system aims to handle both home wifi connectivity and the management up to 100 ZigBee and Bluetooth devices.

To do so it can identify the strongest path and connection for every device, even those in the backyard.

TP-Link also claims security is top notch, since it includes Trend Micro HomeCare antivirus and malware protection complete with malicious site blocking.

The Deco M9 is available as a 2-pack, and customers can buy separate boosters to further add to the mesh network.
