

Cisco Boosts Router Solution

Cisco describes its Linksys E4200 router as its best-in-class wireless networking solution-- with speeds of up to 450 Mbps.

The router carries simultaneous dual-band wireless-N, x4 gigabit ports and 3x3 antenna configuration in sleek industrial design. Combining its 6 antennas with internal and external amplifiers also boosts its signal strength.

It comes with a USB port, through which customers can turn the E4200 into a UPnP media server-- storing and sharing media through their network. The USB port also acts as a virtual USB port, enabling wireless printing.

The included software provides users with simple setup and network management tools.
