

Corsair adds to the Dominator Platinum memory series with a pair of 32GB DDR 4kits featuring quite the mouthful of a name-- the Dominator Platinum Special Edition Torque.



Essentially a fancy version of the previous Dominator Platinum RAM, the Torque model features a top bar heat-treated to look similar to the exhaust manifolds of high-performance engines. It also carries integrated white LEDs for a bit of extra flair. The black aluminium heatsinks get a brushed metal finish, while the cooling fins are in a fetching shade of orange.

The Torque memory kits are available in 2x16GB and 4x8GB versions. Both offer identical specifications, being overclocked at 3600MHz speeds, and are designed for Intel X99 and 200-series motherboards.
