

At SIGGRAPH 2017 Dell celebrates the 20th anniversary of its Precision workstation with a special edition of the Precision 5520 mobile workstation, as well as the launch of the Canvas "smart workspace."



The anniversary edition of the Precision 5520 features an exclusive hard anodised brushed aluminium finish in a new colour, Abyss. It also includes an anti-finger print coating, and ships in two "high-end" configuration options. These include a 15.6-inch UHD IGZO touchscreen, Intel Core i7-7820HQ CPU, Nvidia Quadro M1200 GPU, 8GB DDR4 RAM, 256GB SSD, x2 USB 3.0 ports, card reader, HDMI out, Thunderbolt 3 port and headphone jack.



Meanwhile the Canvas is a machine first shown off at the Adobe MAX conference back in November 2016. It is essentially a 27-inch QHD touchscreen designed for creative use, with touch, precise inking and Surface Dial-style tactile rotary screen tools. It is not a tablet or AiO machine, since it still requires pairing with a Windows 10 PC, and promises to allow users to "create, communicate, and express your thoughts and ideas as naturally as on paper."

Also launched at SIGGRAPH are next generation workstations-- the Precision 5820 Tower, 7820 Tower, Precision 7920 Tower and Precision 7920 Rack, all "completely redesigned inside and out to power even more creative workflows."
