

LG Refreshes Gram Laptops

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LG refreshes the Gram laptop range ahead of CES 2018-- all promising to "push the boundaries of portable computing" with bigger 72Wh batteries allowing a "full day" of use on a single charge.



The 2018 Gram laptop range comes in 13.3-, 14- and 15-inch sizes. Specifications vary, with LG offering 8th generation Intel Core i5 and i7 processors and SSD storage (with the option of a second SSD). The IPS touchscreen handles 1920 x 1080 resolution, while connectivity comes through Thunderbolt 3.

The body is built in a nano carbon magnesium alloy, a material LG says is 20% more durable than traditional magnesium products. As a result, the laptops pass MIL-STD 810G durability tests against impact, pressure and temperature.

“We’re very proud to introduce the new Gram PCs, which have been designed in direct response to those wishing to get an all-round, high performance laptop with maximum portability,” the company says. “LG offer more powerful laptops that deliver greater work efficiency and durability while continuing the product’s original identity of offering lightest laptop in its category.”

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
