DisplayPort support) ports. On the multimedia side the notebook has a webcam, stereo speakers, microphone array and 3.5mm audio jack. All come inside a sturdy thick plastic chassis Acer says can withstand drops reaching up to 122cm and liquid spills of up to 342.5ml. The Spin 311 should also survive 59% - 88% humidity, temperatures between -32°C and +49°C, and vibrations of up to 7.7 G per axis. Such protection does make for a chunky machine, being 23.5mm thick and 1.5kg heavy.
