ZTE launches the Nubia Prague S-- an incremental upgrade on the My Prague seen back in August 2015 featuring the eye scanner and touch-sensitive edges seen in the Nubia Z9 and Axon Elite.



The smartphone features a 5.2-inch 1920x1080 resolution display together with an octa-core Snapdragon 615 processor, 3GB RAM and 64GB storage inside an all-metal body. The 8MP front-facing camera doubles as the aforementioned eye scanner, allowing users to unlock the phone by simply looking at it.

Users can also open apps, summon the camera or adjust display screen brightness by tapping and swiping on the touch-sensitive edges.

Further tech details include a 2200mAh battery, dual-SIM support and 13MP camera. The OS of choice is Android 5.02, with no word from ZTE as yet regarding an Android 6.0 upgrade.

The Nubia Prague S is available from January 2016 in silver or rose gold in ZTE's home China. The company is still to confirm whether the handset will make it to our side of the world.
