Huawei announces the European debut of the Honor 5C, a followup to the budget-priced Honor 5X handset first seen back at CES 2016.



While being on the lower end of the smartphone spectrum, the Honor 5C features decent enough specs. It is a 5.2-inch device with a 1920x1080 resolution IPS display, a Hisilicon Kirin 650 octa-core CPU, 2GB RAM, 16GB storage and a 3000mAh battery.

Further additions include a 13MP camera with f.2.0 aperture, HDR and a fingerprint-resistant lens coating, 8MP front-facing camera and an aluminium body complete with non-scratch coating. The OS of choice is Android 6.0 as modified with Huawei's EMUI 4.1 software.
