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Logitech upgrades its earlier take on living room conferencing with the TV Cam HD-- a single device with built-in Skype hooking up your customers' HDTVs without the need for a PC.



It has all processing power required to not only run Skype, but also send wide-angle 720p footage over wifi or ethernet connections. As the company says, all it needs is an available HDMI port, an internet connection and a Skype account.

Unlike the previous TV Cam model the TV Cam HD does not need a Viera Connect HDTV-- any TV with HDMI-in is ideal.

"Powerful" image processors brighten images, while Carl Zeiss provides the camera optics. Four noise-cancelling microphones complete with beamforming and unidirectional technologies handle audio, and control comes through an easy-to-use remote.

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
