

Epiphan Announces AV.io HD Video Grabber

Epiphan Video launches the AV.io HD-- a device the company describes as an easy-to-use video grabber for customers wanting to capture video from HDMI, DVI and VGA sources.



The AV.io HD allows users to connect any device with an HDMI, DVI or VGA output, including cameras, laptops, tablets, projectors, game consoles and embedded devices to a Windows, Mac or Linux PC without need for any additional drivers or add-ons.

It appears on PCs as a webcam-style video source, making it compatible with software such as Skype, Wirecast and QuickTime.

Epiphan says the AV.io captures 1080p video at 60fps with near-zero latency and high reliability. It comes as a palm-size device enclosed in all-aluminium casing, making it ideal for video capture anytime, anywhere and from any source.
