

A Small Case for EATX Motherboards

Cubitek announces what it says is the smallest case in the world supporting EATX motherboards-- the Magic Cube AIO, an aluminium case measuring just 24 x 49 x 48cm.



Ideal for customers wanting their hardware within a small footprint, the Magic Cube AIO holds one 3.5" HDD and one 2.5" SSD on top of the 5.25" optical drive cage. A second 3.5" HDD fits below the same drive cage, and one can install three more 3.5" HDDs and one more 2.5" SSD behind the motherboard tray.

It also has space for VGA cards of up to 360mm in length and x8 PCI slots. Providing cooling are x2 front, x1 rear and x1 top 140mm fans, all with blue LED illumination. Customers can also install further CPU coolers (180mm maximum height).

Cable management is also simple, with x4 USB ports and gold-plated audio input/output on the front panel.
