The Lenovo PC lineup gets a number of additions, including a pair of Flex 2 dual-mode laptops and the gesture control-enabled A540 AIO desktop, among others.



The Flex 2 laptops are (obviously) updates on the first Flex range, with industrial design featuring 300° flexibility and two usage modes, Laptop and Stand.

Models are available in either 14- or 15.6-inch sizes, both with 1920x1080 resolution displays, Nvidia or AMD graphics and either 4th generation Intel Core i7 processors or AMD A8 APUs. The laptops also feature Dolby Advanced Audio v2 technology and storage in either HDD, hybrid SSHD or SSD formats.

Meanwhile the A540 AIO includes a 23.8-inch 1920x1080 IPS display in a thin aluminum shell. It runs on Windows 8.1, supports 10-finger touch input and is powered with Nvidia GeForce GT 840A graphics and up to 4th generation Core i7 CPU.

Input also comes from a built-in Leap Motion controller with support for up to 12 gestures.

It also features JBL Dolby Home Theatre speakers, NFC connectivity and an optional TV tuner.
