The Zotac Zbox line of miniature desktop PCs gets an upgrade to Intel Kaby Lake processors-bringing about the Magnus EN1070K, a machine capable of powering a VR headset despite being a little bigger than a Mac Mini.

The ultra-compact PC runs on a Kaby Lake Core i5 CPU together with an Nvidia GeForce GTX 1070 GPU and up to 35GB RAM. Internal storage comes through M.2 SSD slot and 2.5-inch SATA drive bay, while connectivity includes x2 USB 2.0, x2 USB 3.0, x1 USB 3.1 Type-A, x1 USB-C, x1 SD card slot, x2 ethernet, x2 HDMI and x2 DisplayPorts.

Zotac gives no word when the Magnus EN1070K will be available as yet.
