PC component specialist Phanteks announces a pair of Mini ITX motherboard-compatible cases-- the Enthoo Evolv Shift and Shift X, both featuring a minimalist design with a sleek and slim stature.



The Evolv Shift measures  $170 \times 470 \times 274$ mm, while the Shift X is the taller option at  $170 \times 650 \times 274$ mm. Both are designed for use in either desktop case or tower orientations, and promise to look "clean from every angle." Construction features anodised aluminium panels within a powder-coated steel structure, with top and bottom cooling fins and tempered smoked glass panels on the right and left sides.

Being the bigger case, the Shift X allows for more storage options, with two 3.5-inch drives and four 2.5-inch drives (whereas the Shift holds one 3.5-inch/three 2.5-inch drives). It also allows for more cooling fans and larger graphics cards (529mm, as opposed to 350mm). Both chassis also have space for an 82mm CPU cooler.

The two cases have a design providing users with 360-degree access of the system-- so much so the top panel swings open on a hinge and the GPU bracket is reversible. Also included is integrated RGB lighting customers can sync with RGB motherboards and other Phanteks RGB products.

The Evolv Shift and Shift X will be available to retailers from August 2017 in Anthracite Grey and Satin Black colour options.
