

Samsung Intros Portable SSD T5

Samsung announces a successor to the Portable SSD T3-- the Portable SSD T5, with transfer speeds leveraging on the USB 3.1 gen 2 interface to reach up to 540 MBps.



The T5 is a small device measuring around the size of a business card. It weighs 51g, offers up to 2TB capacity and includes AES 256-bit hardware encryption to ensure the protection of sensitive data. Also included is Dynamic Thermal Guard Protection technology, which monitors and manages operating temperature in order to reduce overheating.

Construction features a full metal shock-resistant internal frame Samsung says can withstand drops of up to 2m on a hard surface. On the outside is a rugged, rounded-metal unibody. The package includes a Type-C to C and Type-C to A cables for immediate access, and the drive is also compatible with Android devices.

The T5 is available in four sizes and two colours-- 250 and 500GB in "Alluring Blue," and 1 and 2TB in "Deep Black."
