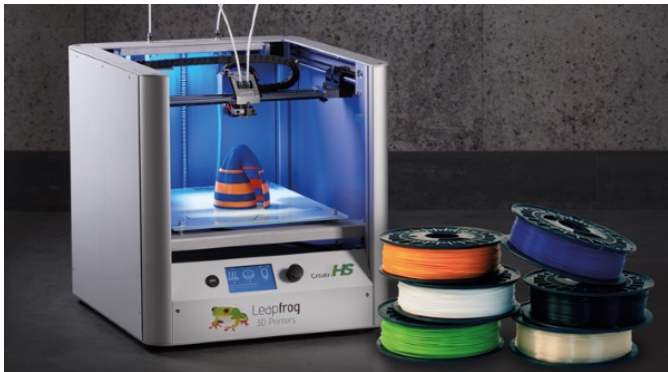


Ingram Micro Opens Euro 3D Printing Division
