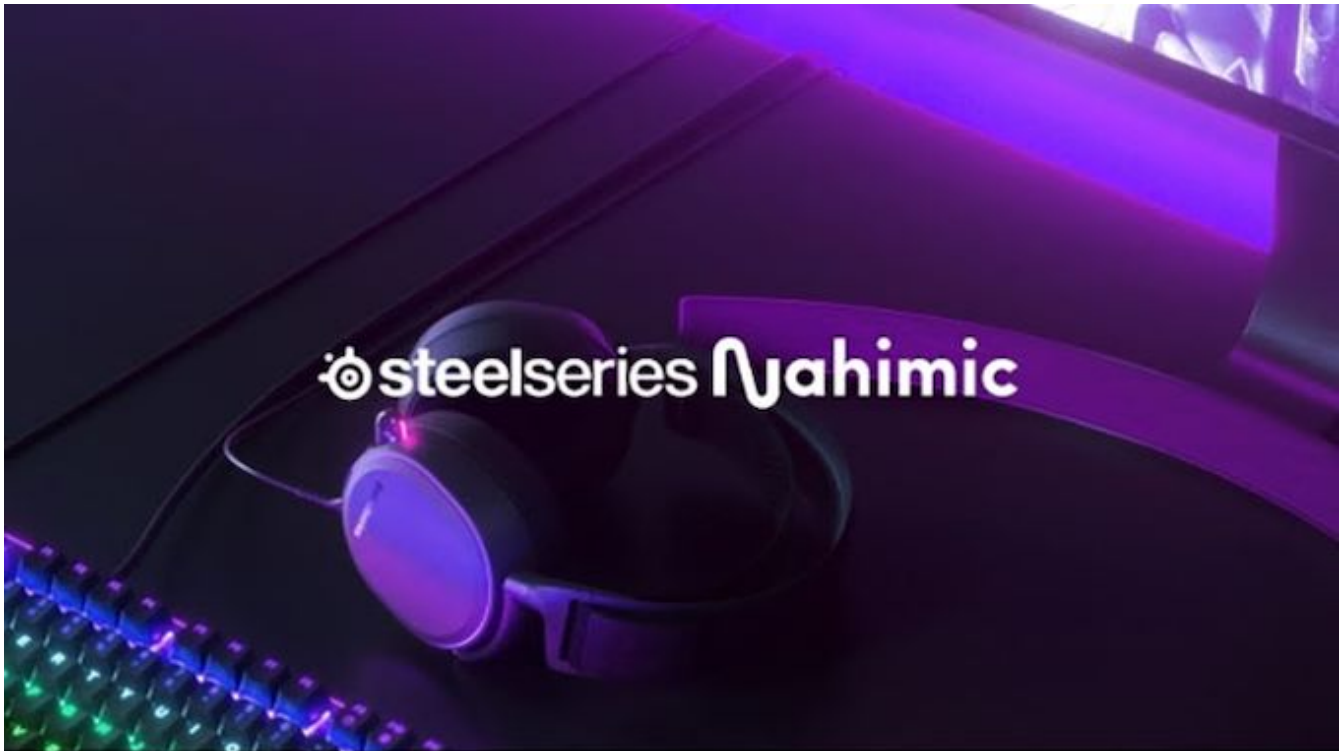


SteelSeries Buys A-Volute
