Developed by Zero Zero Robots, the Hover Camera Passport is a foldable drone built from carbon fibre material. It weighs just 242g and carries a 13MP camera with 4K video support and the ability to capture 360-degree panoramic video. Battery life clocks at around 10 minutes per charge, and the makers promise the Passport is very easy to use, with artificial intelligence allowing anyone to operate both indoors and outdoors.

Control comes via companion iOS app complete with an automated media editing app allowing one to create short video cips by selecting and editing the best photos and videos.

The Passport is available in select Apple Stores as an exclusive package complete with drone, 2 batteries, charger, adapter and easy-carry bag. Outlets will also offer hands-free demonstrations.
