

SlingCatcher: One Device to Rule Them All

The Slingbox is one of the great all-time hits for home viewing but hasn't resonated in Europe the way it does in USA. The newest product, the SlingCatcher, may change this.



SlingCatcher does the opposite of the original SlingBox: instead of "slinging" TV transmissions, it "catches" media streams and then slings them onto your TV or PC. It can capture media from other SlingBoxes in the house, from USB drives and anything streamed from your PC (video, internet or desktop).

If you can play a video on your PC, you can project it to your TV with SlingCatcher. This is great for viewing Internet video from your web browser, downloaded movies from your hard drive, or even photo slideshows on your TV. Attach a USB drive to SlingCatcher and enjoy your family movies, downloaded videos, podcasts, and more - all on your TV. Watch video from any device connected to your Slingbox (cable, satellite, DVR, or DVD player) on a TV in your home or someplace else.

You can use SlingCatcher with your home TV... or with a TV on the other side of the globe. You can even watch live or recorded TV in a room that's not wired for cable or satellite, eliminating the need to purchase additional devices and cable subscriptions for every television in your home.
