The device also features IP67-rated dust and water resistance, 3m drop tolerance, 2 ton crush resistance and the ability to survive for up to 30 minutes in 1m of water.

The Rugged SSD has the same ruggedised capabilities of the Pro model, only without the Thunderbolt 3 capability. Available in capacities up to 2TB, it carries a FireCuda NVMe SSD with USB 3.1 connectivity and Seagate Secure self-encrypting technology. Meanwhile the Rugged BOSS SSD carries a battery, allowing use as a portable power pack for USB devices, and features a built-in status screen providing real-time updates on transfers, capacity and battery life.
