

Microsoft Claims 900 Million Win 10 Users

Windows 10 is running in over 900 million devices Microsoft reports, with the past 12 months adding more devices "than ever before." If growth continues at such a pace the OS is set to reach 1 billion devices by Q1 2020, at least according to Thurrott.
